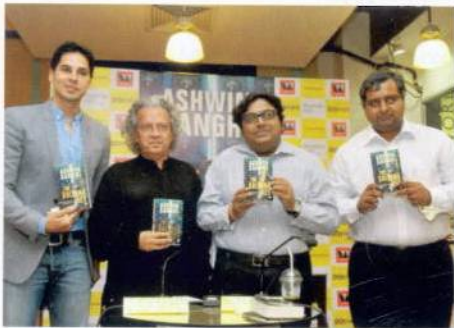


'The Krishna Key'

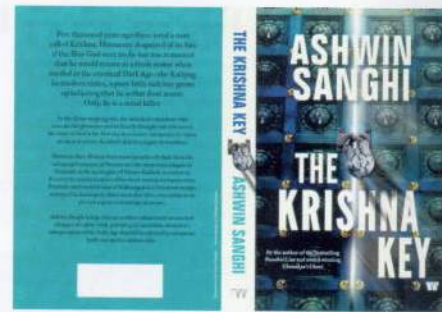


About the Book:
